

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROOF OF POSSESSION – BANK ACCOUNTS

If this form has been required by the court, it serves to show the court that the accounts previously reported, still exist, if they are “Restricted” (if the court ordered), and the balance in the account.

Each bank that the ward/minor ward/protected person has accounts will need to fill out one of these forms.

1. HEADING

- a. Choose the county in the drop-down box below the first blank.
- b. Enter the case number assigned by the clerk of the court.
- c. Enter the name of the ward/minor ward/protected person.
