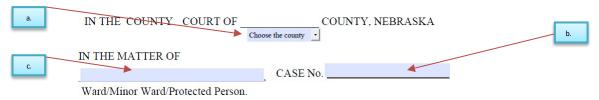

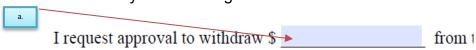
1. **HEADING**

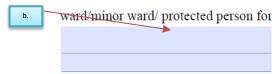


2. BODY OF FORM

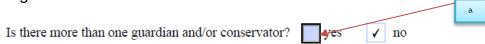
